Materials

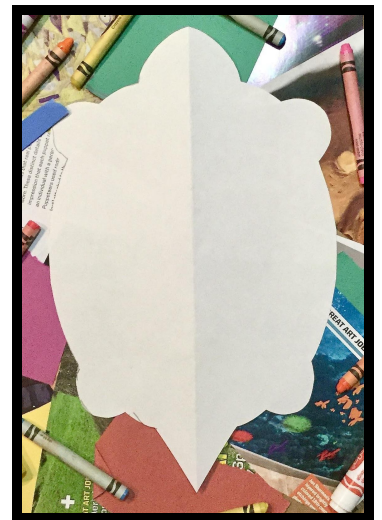
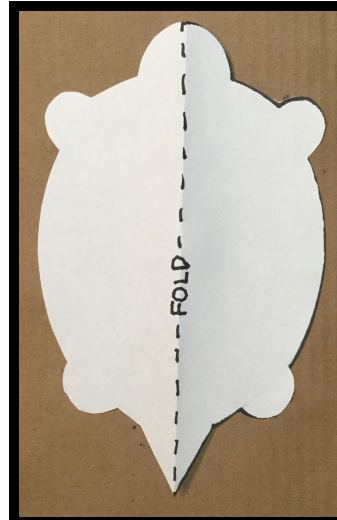
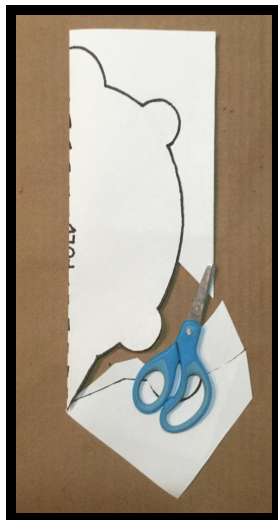
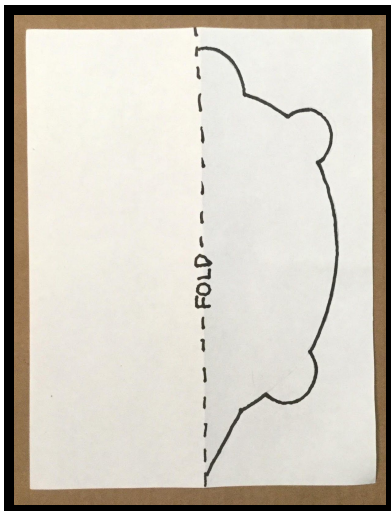
- a.) 9" x 12" paper
- b.) magazine clippings
- c.) scissors
- d.) markers
- e.) glue
- f.) sequins, buttons, etc.



Steps

- 1.) Fold and draw half of the turtle from middle fold.
- 2.) Cut making sure that the paper is still folded.
- 3.) Embellish with cut paper and whatever you might find.

Vocabulary : *symmetry, pattern, sea turtle, warm color, cool color, embellish, place*



This project may require some help to get the little ones started. However, once they get started they're on their own. This can be a learning activity
