

An Owl in My Tree

Let's make an owl to put in your tree!

You'll need:

- Paper plate
- Crayons, markers, or paint
- Scraps of colorful paper
- String or yarn to hang your owl



First fold down the top curve of your paper plate to make your owl's face, then fold in both sides to make its wings.



Color or decorate your owl in any way you like.



Snip a tiny hole into the top of your owl and tie a **BIG** knot in one end of your string or ribbon.



Put the string or ribbon through the hole...



...then tie to a tree. Now there's an owl in your tree!
