

# Fun, Animated, Clowning Around Robot People

## Follow the Steps:

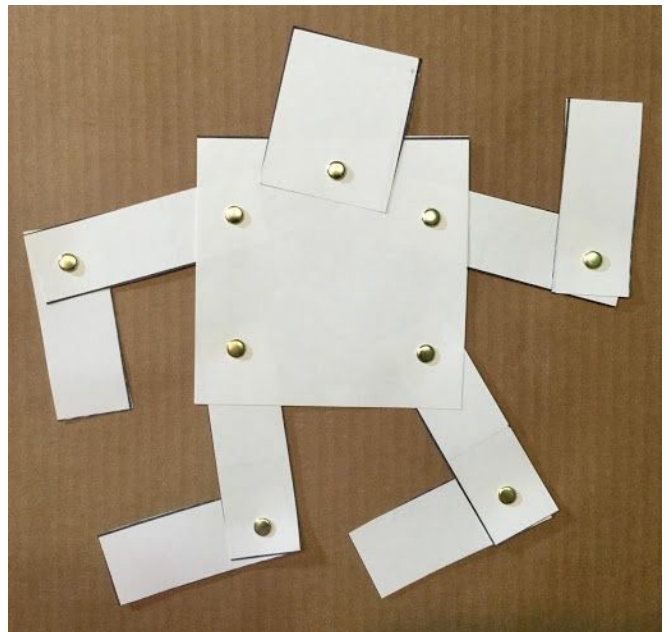


1.) Using a 9" x 12" piece of heavy paper draw the pattern layout and hole marks.



**2.) Cut on the lines with scissors and punch holes where indicated. If you don't have a hole punch, just use the tip of a pencil, pen, or toothpick to make the holes.**

**3.) Line up the holes and insert brad fasteners to attach arms, legs, and head. If you don't have brad fasteners, try using string, paperclips, or glue to attach the body parts.**



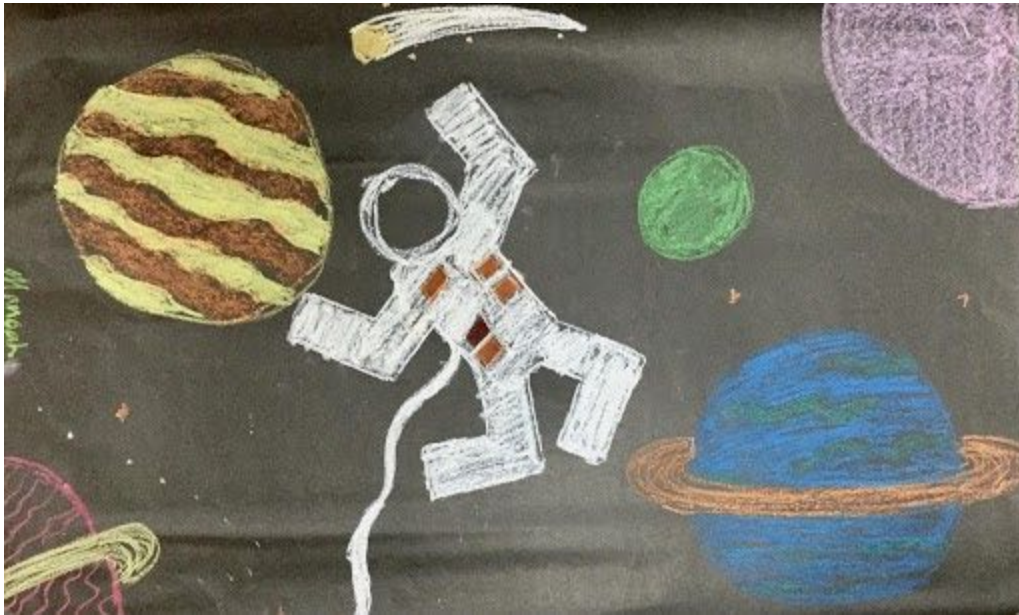
**4.) Embellish with beads, sequins, yarn, and various other decorative materials you find around the house.**







**Take it a step further and try putting them in a place by creating a background. Or, mount them on a stick and turn them into puppets. Then you can put on a show!**
